You are invited to participate in the 2010 – 2011 ASA – PPG Practice-a-thon. This is a tax deductible fundraising project to support the ASA-PPG Playathon Concert which will be March 5 at Katzin Hall at ASU (the big recital hall downstairs so you can invite your friends and relatives).

You promise to practice 100 days and ask your friends and relatives to pledge a certain amount for every day you practice paying only if you complete your 100 days. No amount is too small or too large. If your friend will pledge one penny a day, you will have earned \$1.00 for the recital. If your aunt will pledge one dollar a day, she will have a \$100.00 tax deduction!

You will be provided with a sample request letter which you may use or you may make your own. You will also be given a pledge sign-up list and on the reverse side will be your 100-day practice recording chart. When you have completed your 100 days, you will collect your pledges and give them with the practice chart to your teacher.

All participating students will receive a ribbon. There will be a prize for the person who collects from the highest number of pledge supporters and a prize for the person who collects the highest dollar amount of pledges.

To complete your 100 days in time to qualify for the Playathon Concert, you must sign up no later than November 15, 2010.

We know you can do this and we think that with all students practicing 100 days, the Playathon Concert will be fantastic. We know this will be fun and we look forward to your participation. Work hard and good luck!
