Our goal is for this recital to become an outstanding annual event with performances so good that people ohh and ahh and every teacher can be very proud of each student's performance. We felt it was necessary to provide some guidelines to help teachers plan ahead so that together we can create this high level artistic concert.

Each student who is a member of ASA-PPG may perform 1 piece in the concert, which could be a solo, a movement of a Sonata/Sonatina, a duet with another student or as part of an ensemble with strings. (Students may submit an additional choice with their teacher's approval and if there is room in the recital they may be able to perform a solo and also a duet/ensemble piece.) For each piece played students will need to pay the \$30.00 participation fee.

Any solo from the Suzuki Piano repertoire is automatically approved. All other choices need to be submitted to the ASA-PPG teachers no later than November 12 for approval.

We will have 2 pianos available for student 2-piano duets if needed. For those who wish to play a Sonatina/Sonata for which there is a McSpadden string accompaniment, we will find strings to play for students who wish to play with them. The additional cost will be \$30.00.

Basically we do not want pop music, transcribed music, or most blues/jazz/rock.
